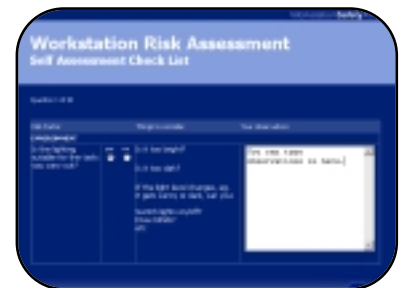

Try before you buy

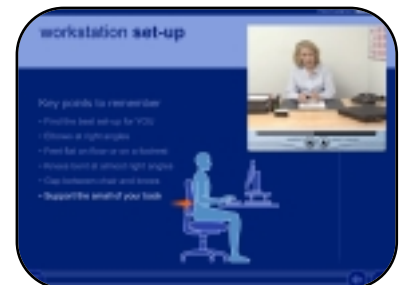
